Therefore, CSU must reserve the right, even after fees are initially charged or initial fee payments are made, to increase or modify any listed fees. All listed fees, other than mandatory systemwide fees, are subject to change without notice, until the date when an instruction for a particular semester or quarter has begun. All CSU listed fees should be regarded as **estimates** that are subject to change upon approval by The Board of Trustees, the Chancellor, or the Presidents, as appropriate. Changes in mandatory systemwide fees will be made in accordance with the requirements of the Working Families Student Fee Transparency and Accountability Act (Sections 66028 – 66028.6 of the Education Code).

Title 5, Section 89700 of the California Code of Regulations allows resident students to pay Tuition Fee on an Installment Payment Plan. A processing fee of \$33 per semester for California resident students is charged to offset the administrative costs of this plan. **This processing fee is nonrefundable**, even if students are denied participation in the plan, later withdraw from the plan, receive financial aid or do not attend CSUF.
